The abstract should contain: 1) title of the paper, 2) authors' name and affiliation, 3) paper abstract, 4) keywords, 5) name, full address, phone number, fax number, and email address of the author to whom subsequent correspondence should be directed. The abstract will be reviewed and should include the objectives, results, and conclusion. Final acceptance will be determined based on the assessment of the abstract. All accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings that will be published in bound volumes available after the conference.
